

- Laser pointers.
- Hover boards, segways, skateboards, castor boards, bicycles, or equivalents.
- Wagons or carts—strollers, walkers, wheelchairs and equivalents are permitted.
- Pets. Service animals are permitted.
- Flags on poles or sticks that do not fit into a backpack.
- Cremated remains.
- Glass containers.
- Anything else deemed hazardous or suspicious by security.

Items Permitted in the Museum

- Backpacks smaller than 22 × 14 × 9 in.
- Baby milk and formula
- Sealed or empty water bottles
- Strollers
- Medication
- Service animals
- Cameras
- Hand-carried sketchbooks and pencils

Visitor Policies

- No food, drinks, or chewing gum in the exhibit galleries.
- Visitors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult
- No flash photography in exhibit galleries

Photography Consent
